#### NHS Immunisation Team - Flu Vaccination Reminder

The nurses will be attending Churchfields on **Tuesday 21st October** to give the flu vaccine. **If you have already completed a consent form, please do not complete a second form.** If you have not already completed it, please <u>click on this link</u> or scan the QR code and complete it before the session next week.



If there are any changes in your child's health for example, they have had an increase in their asthma medication, taken steroid tablets in the last 2 weeks, or have worsening asthma symptoms then you must let your school know to pass on the message to us.

Also, if they are unwell or if they have received the vaccination at your GP's surgery since completing the form, then please inform the school by 8.30am on the morning of the vaccinations informing us of the changes. Minor illness without fever is not a reason to postpone vaccination. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact the Immunisation Team Bromley directly on 020 3903 3375.

# Scarlet Fever/Strep A - NHS advice

Scarlet fever is usually a mild illness, but it is highly infectious. Therefore, look out for symptoms in your child, which include a sore throat, headache, and fever, along with a fine, pinkish or red body rash with a sandpapery feel. On darker skin, the rash can be more difficult to detect visually but will have a sandpapery feel.

Contact NHS 111 or your GP if you suspect your child has scarlet fever. If your child has scarlet fever, keep them at home until at least 24 hours after the start of antibiotic treatment to avoid spreading the infection to others.


#### Half Term Childcare



We work with Premier Education (formerly called YoungStars) to provide holiday childcare at Churchfields. Their next camp will take place over the Autumn Half Term. You can <u>find out more and book here</u>. Every day is different with a mix of fun activities that children may not have tried before. Camps run from 8.15am - 5.15pm (full day) or 8.30am - 12.30pm / 1pm - 5pm (half day). The camps are open to children aged 4 - 11 years. Reception children can be accepted for full days. Camps cost £40 per session for a full day or £20 per session for a half day. Childcare vouchers are accepted, and discounts are available for siblings or for referring a friend.
