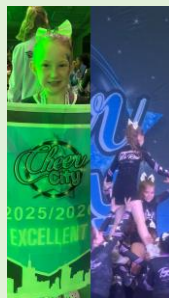

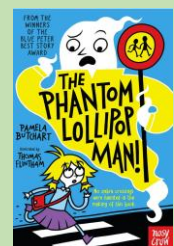
## Pupil Achievements
