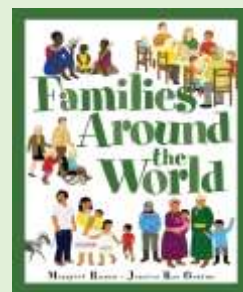

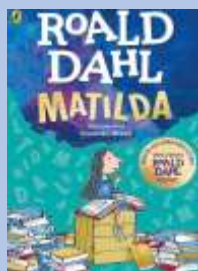
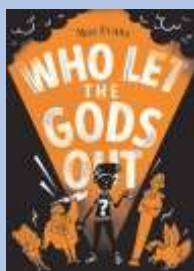
## Amazing Achievements
