



Community Paediatric Referral

A paediatric referral can be made for many reasons, including social communication needs and ADHD related concerns.

A referral to the Community Paediatrician is made to Bromley Healthcare. School will discuss the need for a referral with parents / carers and a referral will only be made if both parties agree.

Dependant on the reason for the referral, families may need to complete a questionnaire or form to make up part of the referral, this will be explained at the time of agreement.

Class teachers will also complete a form and the SENCo will write a letter for referral. This will then all be submitted to the NHS (Bromley Healthcare).

Once a referral is accepted, families will be contacted and informed of waiting times and appointment dates.

Bromley Healthcare do not send communication to school after the referral has been submitted – we are not told of appointment dates or outcomes, so rely on families to share this information with us.
